

Thank you to those who have already donated in Randy's memory and for those who haven't but still want to, there will be opportunities to donate during the meeting. The scientific program is jointly provided by the AANS and attendees will be eligible for CME.

As always, we will break from talks about brain and spine surgery around mid-day and have ample time to catch up with old friends, make new friends and explore Monterey. We are particularly excited this year to spend our local's night at the world-famous Monterey Bay Aquarium. On Saturday night we will enjoy a private event with a hosted bar and strolling dinner in the Ocean's Edge Kelp Forest Wing of the Aquarium. You won't want to miss it! Afternoon group activity options being coordinated by our Local Arrangements Chair, Dr. Ciara Harraher, include a guided wine tour, private bike tours and a kayak tour along Cannery Row.

# Point Lobos Natural Reserve Hiking Tour Tour, Saturday or Sunday (self-organized). \$75 per person.

Take a guided hike through the diverse landscape of Point Lobos. See rare plant communities, seabirds, endangered archaeological sites, and unique geological formations. The hiking trails follow the shoreline and lead to hidden coves. The park has over 22 trails that intertwine with each other to create a unique experience. Most of the trail is at sea level.
