Thank you to those who have already donated in Randy's memory and for those who haven't but still want to, there will be opportunities to give during the meeting. The scientific program is jointly provided by the AANS and attendees will be eligible for CME.

As always, we will break from talks about brain and spine surgery around mid-day and have ample time to catch up with old friends, make new friends and explore Monterey. We are particularly excited this year to spend our local's night at the world-famous Monterey Bay Aquarium. On Saturday night we will enjoy a private event with a hosted bar and strolling dinner in the Ocean's Edge Kelp Forest Wing of the Aquarium. You won't want to miss it! Afternoon group activity options being coordinated by our Local Arrangements Chair, Dr. Ciara Harraher, include a guided wine tour, private bike tours and a kayak tour along Cannery Row.

## **BIKE AROUND MONTEREY!**

#### Adventures by the Sea

Located just steps from the Portola Hotel and Spa and Old Fisherman's Wharf and on Cannery Row, Adventures by the Sea offers a variety of outdoor activities along with family bike (four-wheel) rentals as well as standard bikes and electric bikes. They are great for discovering the beautiful Monterey Peninsula along the recreation trail, around the rocky shores of Pacific Grove, and into the breathtaking 17-Mile Drive, Alternatively, you can explore the kelp forest and abundant marine life along Cannery Row or Stillwater Cove from an ocean kayak or rent a stand-up paddleboard (Cannery Row location). It's easy to book your bike rentals through the following link - rentals after five need to be done by phone. Bike rentals are scheduled for either half or full days. They provide you with a bike, bike map, helmet, and bike lock.

#### QUICK DETAILS | E-bikes

Location: Either at the Portola Hotel or their Cannery Row location Duration: 4 or 8 hours (\$55 or \$85) When: Daily Age: Minimum age for E-bike riders is 13 with a valid ID.

#### **QUICK DETAILS | Standard Bikes**

Location: Around the corner from the Portola Hotel Duration: 4 or 8 hours (\$40 or \$50) When: Daily

#### QUICK DETAILS | Private Group Bike Tours

Location: Cannery Row Duration: 2.5 hours Length: up to 20 miles When: Daily at 11 a.m. and 2 p.m. Age: Minimum age for E-bike riders is 13 with a valid ID. Private Tours: Booked through their Cannery Row location. Your group can pick the time that works best for you (17 Mile Drive).

### KAYAK CANNERY ROW KELP FOREST!

#### Private Cannery Row Kayak Tour

Paddle through the kelp forest canopy along Cannery Row and experience the Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary. Visit the resident raft of otters that hangs out right in front of their shop! This location is just a short paddle away from both the Monterey Bay Aquarium and the Coast Guard Pier. Both of these areas are prime for wildlife viewing. They guarantee sightings of otters, harbor seals, and sea lions on this two-hour tour.

#### Location: Cannery Row

Duration: 2 hours

When: Daily at 10 a.m. and 2 p.m. (Will need to see if you can customize the tour to your group's timeframe)

They Provide:

- Splash gear
- Life vests
- Booties (if desired)
- Paddling and wildlife orientation

Please bring a towel, hat or sunglasses, and sunscreen.
